Abstracts must ...

- •...be relevant to Astronomy in Africa | South Africa (i.e. it must be on an African | South African project)
- ...include keywords to help define your topic
- •...adequately describe the work to allow reviewers to evaluate the quality, originality, and thoroughness of the work
- •...be submitted in English (the language of the symposium is English, which will be used for all printed materials, presentations, and discussions)
