Should your contribution be accepted, a 1500-word abstract will be required for the electronic abstract publication.

Summaries must ...

- •...be relevant to Astronomy in Africa | South Africa
- •... submitted under one of the five themes: Astronomy around Africa, Astronomy and Society, Astronomy Development, The Future, or Research
- •...adequately describe the work to allow reviewers to evaluate the quality, originality, and thoroughness of the work
- •...be submitted in English
- •...indicate preferred presentation type (oral or poster). While effort will be made to accommodate preferences, final decision rests with the Programme Committee
- •...include keywords to help define your topic
