Should your contribution be accepted, a 1500-word abstract will be required for the electronic abstract publication.

HOW TO SUBMIT

Prepare a 250-word summary of what your abstract will be about, gather all authors' details, and submit electronically here:

Summaries must ...

- ...be relevant to Astronomy in Africa | South Africa
- ... submitted under one of the five themes: *Astronomy around Africa, Astronomy and Society, Astronomy Development, The Future, or Research*
- ...adequately describe the work to allow reviewers to evaluate the quality, originality, and thoroughness of the work
- ...be submitted in English
- ...indicate preferred presentation type (oral or poster). While effort will be made to accommodate preferences, final decision rests with the Programme Committee
- ...include keywords to help define your topic
